

Plant your amaryllis bulb in a pot with soil covering 2/3 of the bulb.

Amaryllis will bloom 4-8 weeks after planting.

When your amaryllis bloom dries up, cut the flower stem at soil level, but keep the leaves intact.

When your bulb is done blooming for the season, place the bulb in a warm sunny location until the danger of frost has passed.

When the danger of frost has passed you can move it outside for a couple of months during the summer.

In August or early September cut off all of the leaves and store in a dark location.

In Late October bring the amaryllis out of dormancy and start the process over again.
